Nikki first worked with WOW! in 2010 on Hot Mikado and has since directed Footloose, Grease, Legally Blonde, Guys and Dolls and Les Misérables for the society. Working with this year's cast on Beauty and the Beast has been a pleasure, and she hopes both cast and audiences alike will enjoy the Disney magic this production brings to the stage.

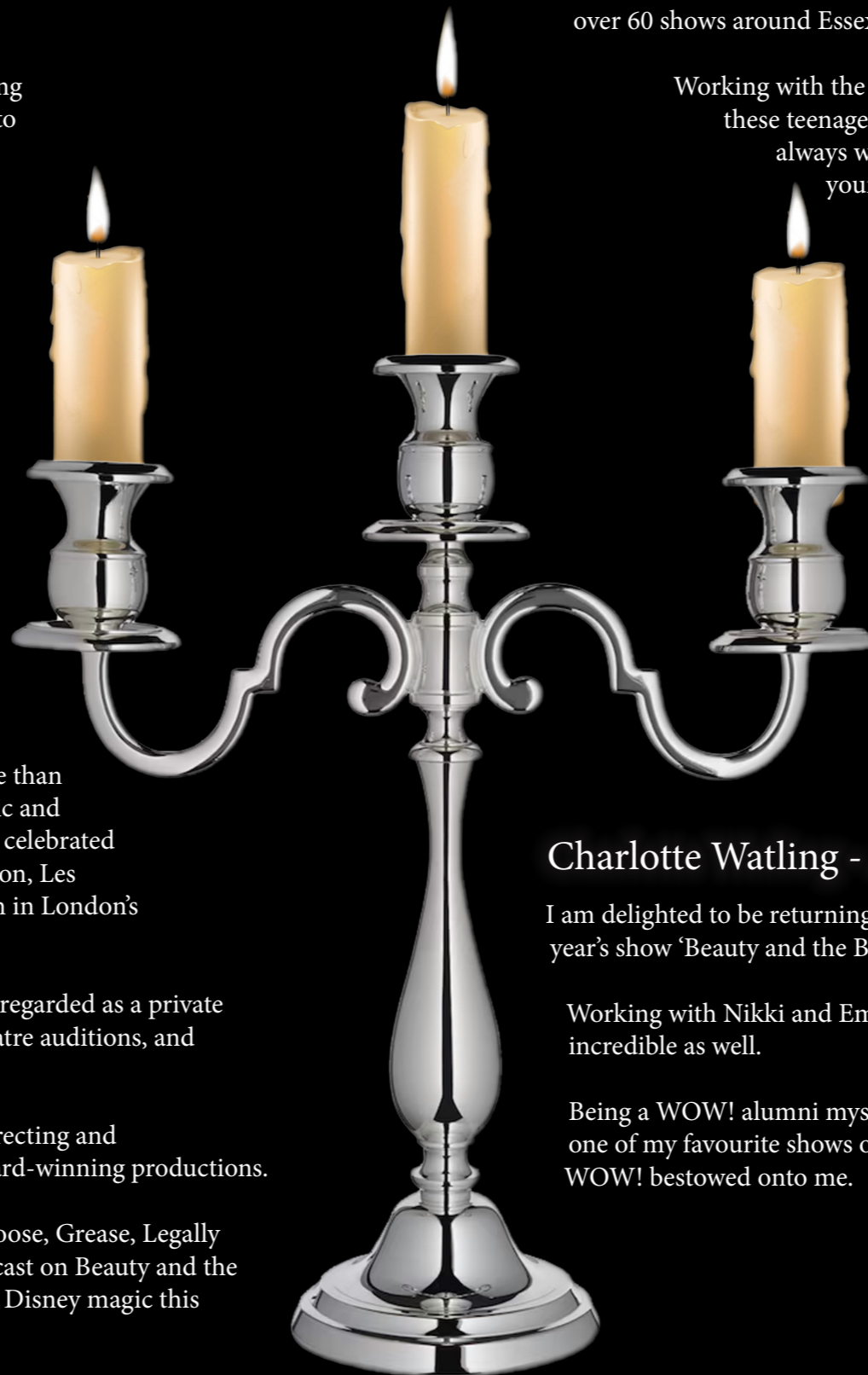
Emma Firth - Musical Director

Being a WOW! alumni myself, I am honoured to be able to assist with one of my favourite shows of all time, whilst passing on the knowledge WOW! bestowed onto me.



Synopsis

The musical begins with Prologue, which tells the story of a selfish young prince who is cursed by an enchantress for his lack of compassion. Transformed into a Beast, and with his servants turned into household objects, he is given one chance to break the spell: he must learn to love and earn love in return before the last petal falls from an enchanted rose.

In a small provincial town, the song *Belle* introduces Belle, an intelligent and imaginative young woman who dreams of adventure beyond her ordinary life. She shares a deep bond with her eccentric inventor father, Maurice. In *No Matter What*, Belle reassures him of her faith and love despite the townspeople's ridicule. As Maurice leaves for a fair, he is set upon by Wolves; *Wolf Chase 1*

The town's celebrated hunter, Gaston, proudly displays his arrogance and entitlement in *Me*, convinced Belle is destined to marry him. Belle quickly makes clear her lack of interest in *Belle (Reprise)*, choosing independence over admiration.

When Maurice becomes lost in the forest and is imprisoned in a mysterious castle, Belle bravely goes to find him and offers to take his place in return for Maurice's freedom. Left alone in an unfamiliar and frightening world, she expresses her fear and determination in *Home*.

Back in the village, Gaston's devoted sidekick Le Fou tries to boost Gaston's mood by reminding him of his popularity and massaging his ego in *Gaston*. Meanwhile, at the castle, the Beast considers his sad predicament with *How Long can this Go On?* The enchanted servants attempt to lift Belle's spirits with a spectacular dinner presentation in *Be Our Guest*. After arguing with Belle, who flees the castle, the Beast reflects on his hopeless situation in *If I Can't Love Her*, believing love may be beyond his reach.

Act II opens with the *Entr'acte*. Overwhelmed and frightened, Belle is ambushed by wolves in the forest; *Wolf Chase 2*. The Beast rushes to her defence, driving the wolves away but suffering serious injuries in the struggle. When the Beast collapses, Belle chooses to stay and help him, guiding him back to the castle and tending his wounds—an act of compassion that forever changes their relationship.

As they recover together, Belle and the Beast begin to see one another differently. In *Something There*, they both realise that their feelings are changing and that genuine affection is beginning to grow. Inspired by this growing connection, the enchanted servants dream once more of their former lives in *Human Again*.

Their bond deepens during a magical evening at the castle, culminating in a romantic ballroom dance underscored by *Beauty and the Beast*, as love begins to bloom. After showing Belle her father lost in the forest in a Magic Mirror, the Beast lets her leave to try and find him. With Belle gone the Beast contemplates his sad predicament *If I Can't Love her Reprise*.

After finding her father, Belle tells him that meeting the Beast has changed her life *A Change in Me*. Gaston plans to lock up Maurice saying he is crazy because he says there is a beast in the castle. But Belle proves it is true showing the townspeople the Beast, in the Magic Mirror.

”Be Our Guest...”

After seeing the Beast in the Magic Mirror Gaston incites the townspeople against the Beast in *The Mob Song*. The mob storms the castle, leading to a dramatic confrontation in The Battle. Though wounded while protecting Belle, the Beast shows compassion rather than hatred.

As the final petal falls, Belle confesses her love, breaking the curse in *Transformation*. The Beast is restored to his human form, and the servants are returned to their true selves.

The story concludes with *Beauty and the Beast (Reprise)*, celebrating love, redemption, and the enduring truth that true beauty lies within.

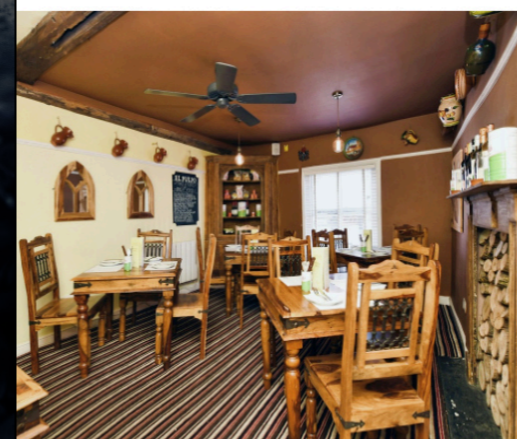

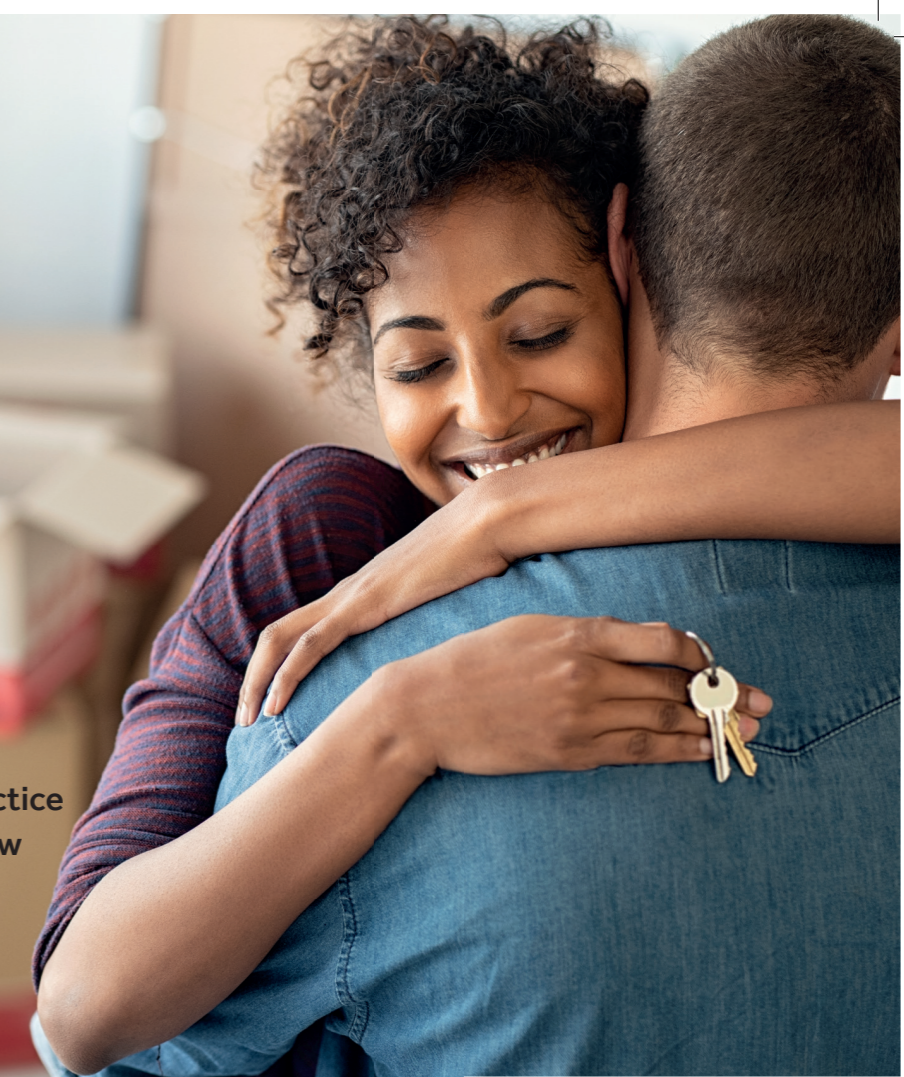
